Twin Cities Public Television is pleased to enter into a partnership with Henry Boucha Films LLC for the purpose of producing a documentary/ drama about Henry Boucha, Ojibwa, Native American Olympian, and visionary. This film is hopefully the first of a series of individual stories of the lives, struggles, defeats, and ultimate achievement of Native American athletes. The Henry Boucha film will contain valuable insights and lessons, as well as values, which carry society- wide implications. TPT and Henry Boucha Films LLC have concurrently, with this letter, entered into a Memorandum of Understanding committing the parties to a co-production of the project.

TPT will be responsible for all aspects of production, postproduction, and preparation for broadcast of the film. Henry will collaborate throughout the production with award-winning TPT Native American producer, Leya Hale. This includes all HD online editing, audio mixing, surround sound placement and layback, design and finishing. TPT is prepared to commit staff to production as soon as funds are made available to TPT. TPT producer Leya Hale is committed to rendering services on this project and her schedule indicates it would be ideal to commence production no later than March 1, 2019.

TPT will also prepare for broadcast and national release via PBS or APT, including national delivery and station relations in 2019-20 including closed captioning, technical evaluations, dubbing for delivery files and back- ups, hard drive for archiving and carriage reporting. TPT will be responsible for presentation of all lead sponsors of the project who will be featured prominently in the film.

While we cannot commit to a specific broadcast schedule until the production is closer to a completion, we look forward to the beginning production as soon as possible.
